
The Pork Rind Process

1. Pork skins are inspected before entering an automatic slicer.
2. The skins are slowly dried and cured with real hardwood smoke.
3. The skins are rendered to remove excess oil and create pellets ready for frying and seasoning.
4. The pellets pass through a separator where they are sorted and graded, then packaged.
5. Sealed boxes of pellets are labeled and sent through a metal detection unit before shipping out around the world.
6. To create the finished pork rinds or cracklins, the pellets are put in frying units where they literally “pop” into crispy snacks.
7. Some rinds are then conveyed to tumblers where they are coated with seasoning blends.
8. The products are then packaged and prepared for shipment to our customers.
